

Helpful Words

In classrooms, helpful words posters display common or high-frequency words which are useful for early reading and writing. Sometimes they include letter-sound correspondences that are unusual or have not yet been taught in the systematic synthetic phonics programme. Some helpful words need to be explicitly taught and their tricky parts pointed out. Floppy's Phonics have organised helpful words into Oxford Levels. On the posters themselves, they are grouped in 'families.' The complete list includes all the tricky words from Phases Two to Five of the Department for Education's framework, Letters and Sounds.
