Gospel=Good News



What would Jesus do? How do Christians decide how to live?

Key word	Definition
Restoration	Returning something to what it was before
Gospel	Refers to the good news which Jesus brought for people.
Foundation	An underlying basis or principle
Parable	A made-up story with a meaning
Denial	Saying something is not true
Narrative	A spoken or written account of an event.
Reconciliation	To restore friendly relationships
The gospels	The first four books of the Bible (Matthew, Mark, Luke John) that speak about Jesus' life, death and resurrection.
