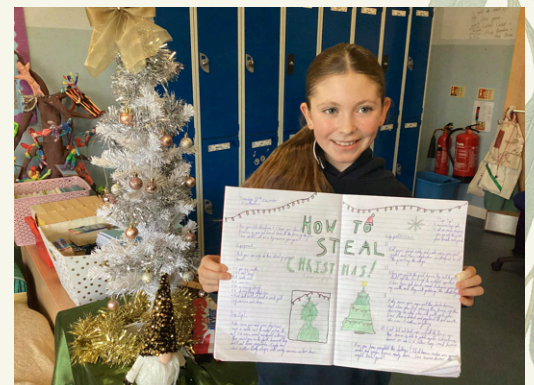
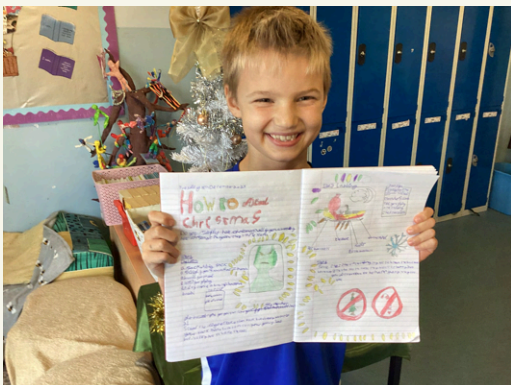
Oak class
